Dear Quilter,

The Hells Canyon Mule Days Quilt Show Committee invites you to participate in our 8th Annual Quilt Show. The show is staged in the Cloverleaf Hall at the Wallowa County Fairgrounds, during the Hells Canyon Mule Days event in Enterprise, Oregon. The HCMD show is the fastest growing mule show in the Northwest and draws visitors from near and far. The quilt show was added to the event line-up in 2003 and the quilt show's success continues to grow each year. The Cloverleaf Hall comes alive with quilts that foster designs from the past and also current day patterns that will amaze and inspire the quilter and non-quilter alike.

The Merchants Mall has been expanded to include not only quilt vendors but artisans with quality crafted goods or products, home and country items, and garden accents... There will be a silent auction with lots of great items, and a Trunk Show highlighting Wallowa County Ranch Women. With these additions to the quilt show we believe there will be a broader market to draw from, and in so doing, it will increase show attendance.

This year there are six categories for our quilt show entries including a new category - "Lost and Found"

F - Lost and Found - "Untold Stories From The Past" • Non Award Category •

Quilt Category Descriptions:

A - Bed Size Quilt: Any technique with a circumference over 250 inches.

B - Crib/Lap Quilt: Any technique with a circumference of 141 to 249 inches

C - Wall Hanging: Item must be intended for use as a wall display. Circumference not to exceed 140"

D - My First Quilt: The work of one person as *the top maker*, with 3 years or less experience. Any size or technique. Quilt may be quilted by hand, machine or tied.

E - Mule Days Challenge Quilt: A quilt that depicts mules and mule days. Circumference: 141 to 200 inches

F - Lost and Found: *Untold Stories From The Past - Quilts that have been acquired and the quilter/story is unknown*

Show Hours: Friday & Saturday - 10:00 am to 5:00 pm • Sunday - 10:00 am to 3:00 pm

Admission is \$3.00 per person with return privileges and children 12 and younger are free.

Entry Deadline: Entry form must be returned by Wednesday, September 1st, 2010. Each quilt must have a separate entry form. Entry form may be reproduced. Forms may be mailed to Hells Canyon Mule Days, Quilt Show Committee, PO Box 50, Enterprise, OR 97828 or hand delivered to Hannah at Savoie's Specialties, 105 SW First Street, Enterprise.

Please Note: Quilts that are not registered by Wednesday, September 1st will NOT be accepted.

Quilt Delivery Info: From September 3rd through September 8th, from 10:00 am to 5:00 pm at Savoie's Specialties, 105 SW First Street, Enterprise or Cloverleaf Hall September 9th, noon to 2:00 pm.

An identification label must be fastened securely to the bottom back right hand corner (as you look at the back) of the quilt. The label must contain the full name, address and phone number as it appears on the official entry form. **Please note** - Mule Days Challenge Quilts - No name on quilt, but your information and a description of quilt must be included when you delivery your quilt.

Claim checks well be given at the time quilt is delivered. Claim checks well be required for quilt pick-up. No quilt will be released without one. **NO EXCEPTIONS.**

Pick-up Info: Sunday, September 12th between 4:00 pm and 5:00 pm at the Cloverleaf Hall.

Quilts For Sale: Quilts entered in the show that are for sale must be indicated on entry form with the price. We will include "For Sale" on your quilt label with your name and phone number so you may deal directly with the buyer. The sold quilt will remain displayed at the show until Sunday at 3:00 pm. The seller will pick-up quilt or indicate name of buyer as **Picked Up by on Quilt Claim Check.**

Visitors will have the opportunity to vote for their favorite quilts in each category, with the exception of the Lost and Found category, and there will also be a Mayors Choice.

Other opportunities offered this year will be Quilt Show sponsors, and advertising in the HCMD Show Program is available for either individuals or businesses. If you or your business would like more information please contact Sondra Lozier - 541-426-3271 or cell 541-263-0104.

We encourage you to enter your quilts and quilted items in our show and multiple entries will be accepted in each category. Quilts must be completed (no quilt tops) **clean** and **odor/smoke free**. Also, enter your special Mule Days Challenge Quilt design and be thinking about what you can buy if you win the \$200.00 cash grand prize sponsored from Hannah Beaudoin at Savoie's Specialties.

The quilt show committee is looking forward to a great show with lots of wonderful quilt entries. We welcome all type of quilts, so we encourage you to enter your grandmothers quilt that has been tucked away, or that special quilt that was a gift for your graduation, wedding, birthday, or some other special occasion. Also, the quilts you have made for your family or home that have added happiness and memories in the making, and your acquired quilts that have *Untold Stories From The Past.*
